Generous red and black fruit aromas precede a soft and supple palate packed with blackberry and cherry flavours with hints of spice.

Soft and round with hints of black currants, good structure and approachable tannins. A full flavoured, easy-drinking classic of the Languedoc.

Approachable with stewed cherry fruit, tobacco and a hint of vanilla essence. A bit of barnyard meatiness but deliciously smooth and very drinkable.

**Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Organic** £19.50

**Colline Teramane, Montipagano 2008**

*Abruzzo, Italy*

Intense bouquet of fresh red fruit and strawberries; on the palate with an intense lingering finish.

**Le Castelmaure** £19.95

**Corbières 2008**

*Languedoc Roussillon, France*

Aromas of ripe raisins and red fruits with a full, silky and supple palate.

**La Mascota Malbec** £23.50

**Bodegas Santa Ana 2008**

*Mendoza, Argentina*

Aromas of black fruits, jam and vanilla, with a subtle licorice touch. Full bodied tannins and a long, pleasant finish.

**Hawkes Bay Pinot Noir** £25.00

**Trinity Hill 2009**

*Hawkes Bay, New Zealand*

Classic, varietal characteristics such as plums, blackcurrants and cherries are evident in this silky textured wine, entwined with earthy, smoky oak notes.

*Bordeaux, France*

Woody and toasty aromas of prunes and liquorice. Fleshy, robust and well-balanced with a firm, lengthy finish.

**Domaine Brusset 2009**

*Southern Rhône, France*

Spicy nose with aromas of Christmas cake and mulled wine. On the palate it is concentrated and very elegant with red and black fruits, soft tannins, and an elegant finish.

*Tuscany, Italy*

Ample, persistent bouquet with plum and red berry tones. The palate is full, with velvety tannins and a long finish.

A dry, poised, an elegant palate with fine grained, well integrated tannins and strawberry fruit flavours finishing dry and soft.
